How do I post a photo on Instagram?

To upload a photo or take a new one, first tap (+) at the bottom of the screen:

- To upload a photo from your phone's library, tap **Library** at the bottom of the screen and select the photo you'd like to share.
- To take a new photo, tap Photo at the bottom of the screen then tap O. You can tap O to switch between front and rear-facing cameras and O to adjust flash.

Once you've taken or uploaded a photo, you can add <u>effects or filters, a</u> <u>caption</u> and <u>your location</u> before posting. You can also <u>post a video</u>.

Note: You can't take or upload photos from a desktop computer.

How do I share a photo or video to my Instagram story?

To share a photo or video to your story using the Instagram app:

- 1. Tap () in the top left of your screen or swipe right from anywhere in feed.
- 2. Tap at the bottom of the screen to take a photo, or tap and hold to record a video. To choose a photo from your phone's library or gallery, swipe up anywhere on the screen.
- 3. Tap Z, Aa or 💽 to draw, add text or a sticker to your photo or video. To remove text or a sticker, drag and
- drop it on at the bottom of the screen.4. When you're ready to share, tap Your Story in the bottom left.

Note: Stories disappear from profile and feed after 24 hours, unless you add them to your profile as <u>highlights</u>.
